### Financing Activities located outside the programme area

The Programme area covers geographical areas in the two participating countries as above. In principle, all activities of a project should take place within the Programme area.

If a project plans to finance activities or events outside the programme area, this is possible in the context of cooperation Programmes. Exceptions to this principle may be granted for EU partners from outside the Programme area and for Assimilated Partners in duly justified cases.

If activities (including travel and accommodation) and/ or events are planned outside the programme area, the following conditions need to be satisfied:

- the activity and/ or event are for the benefit of the Programme area;
- the activity and/ or event are essential for the implementation of the project;
- the implementation and/ or the relevance of the activity and/ or the event have been approved by the Programme beforehand (foreseen in the Application Form or, if not, have been previously authorised by the MA/JS). Infrastructure located outside the Programme area, even if it is directly related to the project either for the development or for implementation, shall not be eligible.

## 2. BUDGET OF THE CALL

The Programme will allocate approximately **7.727.272,00 EUR** (EU & National Funds) to the present Call for Project Proposal. The EU contribution rate is 80 %. Beneficiaries shall ensure the needed own contribution (public and/or private, if applicable).

An indicative budget allocation (EU & National Funds) to the programme priorities and to the specific objectives is presented in Annex I – Table 2. In the context of the present Call, project will be included up to the amount of the budget of the Call. When selecting project to be funded, such allocation may be adapted by the Monitoring Committee (MC) according to programme needs. Project may be selected up to **100%** of the budget of the present Call for Project Proposal, if deemed necessary.

## 3. CONTEXT OF THE CALL

### Background of the opening of the Crossing Point at Prespa'a area

The inception of a border crossing dates back several years ago. The bilateral IPA CBC 2014-2020 Programme contributed significantly to the planning of the current Strategic Project.

In 2022 a preparatory project under the name "BorPres" was approved with budget of € 690.000. The objective of the "BorPres" project was to increase the maturity of the present project in order to proceed with the construction phase under the IPA III during the 2021-2027 Programming Period.

*Partners:* Region of Western Macedonia (LP), Development Organisation of Western Macedonia, Ministries of Interior of partner countries.

*Core activities were the maturation of border-crossing works, namely:*

*Greece:*

Technical works assessment, studies of a building for the Customs and Police Authorities at the border crossing, environmental studies and the issuing of necessary legal licencing,

*North Macedonia:*

Engineering services and tender documentation for the reconstruction and renovation of the SB Police Station. Design of connection to the BCP facilities.

### The 2021-2027 Programming Period

In continuation to the above, the Interreg (IV-A) CBC Programme "Greece - North Macedonia 2021-2027" will proceed with the construction of a building hosting the police and customs authorities on the Greek side of the border and to the renovation of the existing police station on the North Macedonia's side of the borders. The participation of local municipalities in this Strategic Programme will increase the connection of the local communities and population to this flagship project.

The available funds of this Strategic Project will create synergies and will leverage fundings from other financial sources e.g. the funds of the "EU for Prespa" Programme for the constructions of a customs building at the side of North Macedonia, the funds of the RoP of Western Macedonia and the funds of Hellenic Ministry of Interior for the construction of the road connection of the CB Crossing to Point to the national road network and others.

A very close cooperation of relevant public authorities and organizations from both sides of the borders will be needed in order this CB Crossing Point to become functional, proving the ability of the Interreg activities and funds to generate major synergies which leads to large scale changes and development for the cross border area.

#### 4. PROJECT DURATION

Project should be concluded within a maximum period of Thirty six (36) months after the signing of the Subsidy Contract (SC) between the Managing Authority/ General Secretary for Partnership Agreement and the Lead Beneficiary. Project that have started their implementation before the signing of the contract, and in any case after 01/01/2021, should not have been concluded before the application for funding at the present Call for Project Proposal.

This limit applies for the operative phase of the project and does not include the preparation phase.

#### 5. ELIGIBILITY OF PARTNERSHIPS

The project partnersheme consists of the Beneficiaries who are invited by the Present Call

In line with Article 2(9) of the CPR, beneficiaries are responsible for initiating and/or implementing project. They can be public or private legal entities of both participating countries; and shall cooperate in the development and implementation of operations, as well as in the staffing or financing of operations, or both in accordance with Article 23(4) of the ETC Regulation.

#### 6. ELIGIBILITY OF EXPENDITURE

6.1 The end date of the eligibility period for the costs of the proposed operations is defined as 31.12.2029. The end date of the proposed project (completion in both physical and financial terms of the project) should be by the above date.

6.2 Project that have been physically completed or fully executed before the application for funding at the present Call for Project Proposal are not eligible, regardless of whether or not the related payments have been made.

##### 6.3 Project budget requirements (incl. EU & National Funds)

The maximum budget of the submitted project proposal is defined as the amount of 7.727.272,00 €.

6.6 The ERDF co-financing to beneficiaries may be reduced in case of State aid relevance of project activities, in compliance with relevant rules on State aid (see §... of the PM). In such a case State aid is granted under the *de minimis* regime & *GBER* within the project.

6.7 The MA may modify the total amount of the public expenditure of the present Call or may proceed with a justified termination of the validity of the Call, informing in any case the beneficiaries through the programme website (see §... of PM).

6.8 The eligibility rules for the costs of the co-financed operations are specified in Programme Manual.

## 6.10 Expenditures based on simplified cost options.

Direct costs for the calculation of the above amount of Staff Cost, are defined as the sum of the costs of the budget lines "external expertise and services", "equipment" and "infrastructure and works" costs of the beneficiary's budget. The travel and accommodation budget category is not included in the direct costs.

The simplified cost options applied to the project will not be able to be modified either during its implementation or upon its completion.

For all expenses that will be reimbursed using the simplified cost option, Beneficiaries will not provide paid receipts of expenses or documents of equivalent accounting value maintained in the Beneficiary's accounting system.

6.11 Costs within the budget lines "staff costs, travel and accommodation costs and external expertise and services", which have been incurred for the preparation of the project, are eligible for funding on a real cost basis calculation, but should not exceed the amount of €30.000 at project level.

6.12 The management costs of each project beneficiary should not exceed 10% of the its total budget. For the Lead Beneficiary this percentage shall be limited to 15% of its budget.

6.13 Communication' costs cannot exceed 8% of the total project budget and no more than 100.000€, without limits at beneficiary level.

6.14 The Office and Administration costs cannot exceed the 4% of the total beneficiary's budget in both reimbursement option.

6.15 Detailed eligibility rules on activities and related expenditure are described in the Programme and Project Implementation Manual.

## 7. INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECT PROPOSAL/CONCEPT NOTES

**until, exclusively, 11/10/2024, 16:00 greek local time (CET +1) at the latest,**

by the Beneficiary's legal representative (personal user account of the legal representative). After the successful submission of the proposal, the Beneficiary is informed about it through the MIS.

Before the deadline for submitting proposal, it is allowed to resubmit a new proposal after canceling the original proposal. The proposal is evaluated based on the last successful/ valid submission.

The beneficiaries are required to have two personal user accounts (username and password) to access the MIS:

1. the Beneficiary's officer to fill out forms and
2. the Beneficiary's legal representative for submitting proposal, or another user of the system authorized for submission.

If the Beneficiaries does not already have a "Body Code" in the MIS from the period 2014-2020, should apply for a body code.

Instructions for obtaining a Body Code and/or User Account in MIS can be found at Applicant's Package Annexes 16,17.

7.1 The Application Form (AF) is the Beneficiary's proposal and is completed exclusively in the electronic format available at the MIS. Instructions for filling in the fields of the Application Form are attached to the present Call.

The submission of proposal also constitutes an application for funding of the potential beneficiary.

**7.2 The legal documents that prove the Administrative and Financial capability, the authority/competency of the beneficiaries for the implementation of the activities of the specific Project, the regulatory framework for the designation of the body responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Project, the existence and operation of a Branch (if applicable), are required for the evaluation of the project proposal and must be attached to the each Beneficiary's Profile in the "Utilities" section/8.1. Project Bodies Information of the MIS.**

**Note:** In case the necessary documents are not signed by the legal representatives of the Partners, an authorization document from the legal representative of each Partner is required – original or notary certified copy.

## 8. SELECTION PROCESS

After the submission of the proposal by the potential Beneficiary, the selection process and approval of project is as follows:

Phase B1: Administrative & Project Eligibility Assessment

Phase B2a: Quality Assessment

Phase B2b: Beneficiaries Eligibility Check & State Aid Compliance for Project Proposal which have been positively evaluated in phases B1 and B2a

The evaluation of the proposal (Quality Assessment) is performed by two (2) Assessors from the MA/JS and the evaluation procedure is under the control and responsibility of Unit A of the MA.

During the evaluation, the MA/JS may request from the beneficiary, (B1 & B2 Phase) to submit additional information and clarifications, within a specific deadline.

The results of the evaluation (Phases B1, B2a, B2b) are approved by the Monitoring Committee and communicated by the Managing Authority to the Lead Beneficiary via MIS or e-mail.

In response to the above decision, complaints can be raised by the potential Lead beneficiary, which may be submitted within seven (7) working days from the next day after the communication of the Monitoring Committee's Decision. Complaints are examined by the Joint Complaints Committee, based on its rules of procedure approved by the Monitoring Committee.

After the completion of the above procedure, a technical meeting is held between MA/JS and the partnership scheme, where the financial scope of the project is finalized, if required, and the subsidy contract is signed.
