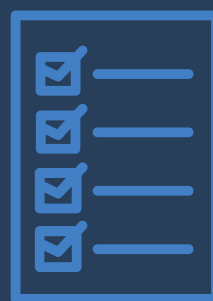

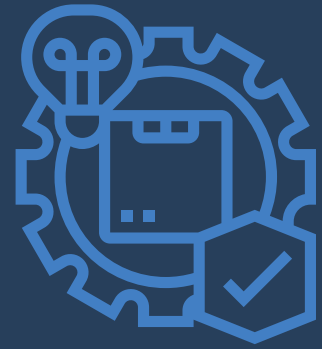

- Establish Prespa as a key destination for regenerative tourism
- Increase cross-border movement
